- ❖ **NEW families pay a one-time \$500 Development Fee (for the first child only)**
- ❖ **When siblings enroll at the school, the second child's tuition will be reduced by 10%, the third child's tuition by 15%, etc.**
- ❖ **Grade placements/teacher assignments are determined by the Head of School**
